

Babylock and Pfaff Intro-This is for all of you who purchased a new Babylock or Pfaff sewing machine from us. In part I, you will learn how to run and care for your new machine, access all of your settings and sewing functions on your machine. Part two is for those of you who also have embroidery capabilities. You will learn how to choose a design and get it to your fabric. Learn how to size, move, rotate, hoop, etc...Everyone else is welcome to come and observe.

Cost: Free

Serger Intro-Welcome to our new Babylock or Pfaff serger owners! What fun a serger can be! You will learn how to thread your serger and sew a 4,3,and 2 thread serged edge and rolled hem. For those of you with more than 4 threads, you will learn the chain stitch, cover hem and combos that can be accomplished with your serger.

Air threading intro is for those Babylock jet-air threading sergers and the mechanical class is for all others purchased from us.

Cost: Free

Beginning Quilting-If you have been interested in quilting and just didn't know where to start, then this is the class for you. We will be teaching not only the basics of fabric selection, preparation, and cutting, but also some of the most common quilting blocks. This will be a 4 part class.

Cost: \$20 for the series and the cost of the book.

Mechanical Serger/sewing machine intro: This class is for any mechanical serger or sewing machine that was purchased here at the store. Come learn how to thread your serger and do the different stitches that make a serger unique. Let us show you how to work your new sewing machine!

Cost: Free

Quilt Binding: For those of you that have taken the Beginning Quilt Piecing class, or are just wanting to learn how to bind and have a project ready for that step, this class is for you.

Cost: \$15

Endless Hooping on the Ellisimo with upgrade #3: For those of you with upgrade #3, come learn how to make the machine line those border designs up perfectly!

Cost: free

Cotton Theory Mystery Quilt block of the Month: This quilt-as-you-go method is great for those that don't want to try and squeeze all that fabric through the neck of your machine. And with this method-when you're done, you're done. Come and enjoy the mystery and watch your quilt come alive block by block. This is an ongoing series that has already began.

Sewing and Embroidery Club: January's sewing club project will be the Sweet Slumber Kit that includes slippers, a small essentials bag, an eye mask, and a pretty little tote to keep it all in. This class will introduce some heirloom techniques as well.

February's class will be the Replappable purse with 3 different flaps. What a great way to change up your purse for each outing!

Cost: \$15 plus supplies

Serger Club: January's class is a great little apron with two pockets and one with a zipper. Yes! You can put in a zipper with a serger.

February's class is a serger caddy to place under your serger. With a place to put your pins and a removable trash/scrap pocket, it's perfect even under a sewing machine.

Cost: \$15 plus pattern

Pfaff 4D/5D Basics: This class will cover the basics of 4D and 5D software systems. Learn the tools and how to navigate within your software. This is the first to come of the Pfaff software classes.

Cost: Free to those who have purchased from Idaho Sewing and Vacuum

Embroidery Basics Towels and T-Shirts: This class will cover the specific techniques and supplies needed to embroider these items. Don't ruin those gifts by using the wrong stabilizer, come learn how to do it correctly and get a good result.

Cost: \$15

Serger Technique Workbook #1: This class will cover all the serging basic techniques as well as how to get a balanced tension. In the workbook is supplied a set of sample fabric for you to make a sample on your serger and keep in your book. There is also a place to write the tension that your machine requires for each stitch so that it is easy to look back and refer to at a later time. This class is open to anyone with a working serger.

Cost: \$15 plus workbook

Ellisimo Tablet class: For Ellisimo Gold owners, or those that have the Ellisimo and have purchased the #2 Upgrade. Come learn how to use the drawing tablet to its fullest potential.

Cost: free

Ellisimo Camera Class: This class is for all Ellisimo and Ellisimo Gold owners regardless of upgrades. We will be using all aspects of the camera from the sewing to the embroidery and the extended use of upgrades #1 and #3.

Cost: free

Palmer/Pletsch Fit Class: In this class, Licensed teacher Karen Marchbanks will show you how to fit that pattern to **your** frame. This will be a 4 part class and is limited to 6 students.
